O 2 Antiseptic cleansing pads O Antiseptic ointment O 6 Band-Aids, various sizes O Moleskin, 2" X 4" O Roller bandage O 2 Safety pins, large O 4 gauze pads O 1 Triangular Bandage O Tape, first aid O Rubber surgical gloves - two pair minimum □ Survival Kit, stored in zip-lock bag or other waterproof container, consisting of: O 1 Chemical Light Stick, Green (T) O 12 wooden, waterproofed matches (T)

- O Match container, waterproof, with striking surface
- O 50' of nylon line (paracord or similar line).
- O Duct tape, 5-10 feet
